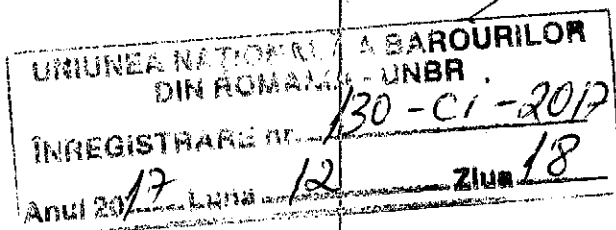

The Portal to International Law** → [www.unalex.eu](http://www.unalex.eu) – *unalex* is a multilingual legal information system on European international private and civil procedural law. *unalex* provides readers throughout the world with unified access to European case law and to helpful supplementary literature on European and international unified law.

*unalex* is a Europe-wide international information system, funded by the European Commission, which consistently implements the idea of the genuine European area of justice - a single European legal area. For this purpose, *unalex* works together with a wide network of European universities and with correspondents in the individual countries.

In addition to the case law of the European Court of Justice, the *unalex* case collection contains more than 8,000 specifically selected decisions of the courts of the Member States that are provided with guidelines and keywords. The *unalex* Compendium, provides structured explanations and commentary, on the application of European Regulations by legal practitioners providing a systematic overview of the jurisdictions included in the case collection. Please find an illustrating example of a Compendium text in the enclosed edition of our legal journal EuLF.

*unalex* is available to lawyers and notaries in all EU Member States who will be able to use *unalex* in languages other than English. Our newsletter provides information about newly included decisions and other current developments.
