



The essential introductory aspects of European cross border family law from experienced European lawyers of the International Academy of Matrimonial Lawyers (IAFL):

This lecture series from the IAFL will comprise a

* 40 minute video each week on key EU rules, followed by

* a 30 minute live webinar presentation each week from international family lawyers of the IAFL

The dates and times are Fridays 8, 15, 22 and 29 November 2024, at 6 pm - Romanian time (i.e. 5 pm CET) on each occasion.

This is a four-week series of recorded webinars followed each time by short (30 mins) live presentation from two experienced European family lawyers from amongst the jurisdictions of England, France, Germany, Italy and Spain. All of the speakers are members of the International Academy of Family Lawyers - the leading organisation for senior experienced family lawyers across the world.

The topics covered in each 40-minute video, and the live presentation, in English language, will be private international law aspects of (week 1) divorce, (week 2) children, (week 3) maintenance, and (week 4) matrimonial property. The videos will deal week by week with each of the main EU regulations in these areas. They are given by experienced law lecturer Professor Ian Sumner who teaches law at Tilburg University and also sits as a judge, and trains judges in the Netherlands.

After the video, the live webinar speakers (two practitioners in each evening session) will talk for 30 minutes about their experience of international work in that field. They will then answer audience questions.
